enjoyed the event.




EMPLOYEE CORNER

After thorough evaluation patient was diagnosed of having Insulinoma - distal pancreatic tumor producing excessive Insulin leading to hypoglycaemia. Under able leadership of **Dr. Manubhai Pipalia** - Exploratory Laparatomy and Distal Pancreatic splenectomy was carried out and the tumour was removed. Patient is relieved of all complaints and well on discharge. Insulinoma is a rare tumour and occurs among one in 10 lac persons annually.
