



Department Of Surgery



In June'21 - July'21 final year University exams for post graduate students were held. In this exam, five students from the department of general surgery appeared. Anaesthesia

A pediatric patient of 5 years of age was posted for left parietal bone tumor excision surgery. MRI report suggestive of neoplastic etiology (Dural based metastasis/ primary Dural malignancy), other blood investigations were normal, HB was 10.7. Surgery was complicated high blood loss was expected as the tumor was above the Sagittal sinus which was open. During Dura dissection, BP started falling due to the high vascularity of the tumor so massive blood loss occur. It was managed with IV fluids and PCV but still, BP was falling, and the patient went into Bradycardia arrest. A patient was prone so it was difficult to give CPR so with help of a neurosurgeon primary closing wound with hemostasis patient turned up in supine position and CPR was started as per ACLS guidelines along with continuous inotropic support. The patient was extubated, off the ventilator, and hemodynamically stable. Anesthesiologist contribution by **Dr. Kinjal Sanghvi, Dr. Sejal Parmar, Dr. Sanjay Baldaniya, Dr. Nikhil Kacha,** and team. Neurosurgery was accomplished by **Dr. Manthan Patel and Dr. Dhaval Chaudhary,** All Nursing and attendant staff did an excellent job. The postoperative course was taken care of by pediatric doctors. It was a great teamwork effort, and the patient was discharged uneventfully with satisfaction by parents.

Physiotherapy: A case study of median nerve injury

A 30-year-old female, presented with a glass injury in the Right forearm, she had complained of pain in the forearm and wrist with weakness in fingers (first three fingers) and thumb with wasting. Electrical stimulation to thenar muscles with 25 repetitions surges faradic with on-time 5 sec, gripping exercises with various instruments was given as treatment. Given home advice with different activity tasks like writing, kneading, turning pages.

Orthopedics

A 33-year-old male patient came to GCS hospital trauma center with a history of road traffic accident 6 hours ago and had multiple fractures in both lower extremities and facial injury. A patient was in hypovolemic shock due to massive blood loss, had altered consciousness, Glasgow score was 6. Primary management was done in casualty and the patient was shifted to ICU. The patient was diagnosed with left femur head fracture with dislocation, left femur neck fracture, left femur shaft fracture, left tibia fracture, left fibula segmental fracture, right femur shaft fracture, right proximal tibia fracture, right talus fracture, and left inferior orbital wall fracture. two-stage surgery was done by Dr. Jyotish Patel and the team. After 2nd surgery patient was kept in ICU for 3 days, then after stabilization, he was transferred into a ward, where he was kept for the next 10 days for a continuation of antibiotics, pain management, and physiotherapy. On discharge, he was vitally stable, able to sit pain-free, and able to mobilize in a wheelchair.




