



## Physiotherapy Department

### Case study: Post-Surgical brachial plexus injury and physiotherapy.

A 24-year-old male patient had a history of post surgery difficulty in moving left shoulder joint, 1.5 month ago.

Co-relating with physiotherapy assessment and MRI investigation was diagnosed with left brachial plexus injury.

After 21 session of physiotherapy treatment with interrupted galvanic(IG) stimulation 100 contraction of each muscle of left upper limb and passive, active assisted range of motion, open and close chain exercise and strengthening exercise ,patient has 80% relief in pain and achieved full active range of motion of left shoulder joint.






